- **Extended papers on the keynote speeches** presented at the joint INDS’11 & ISTET’11
- **Extended paper versions of regular papers** presented at the joint INDS’11 & ISTET’11. These chapters should however incorporate a sufficient introductory part of tutorial nature to make the content accessible to non-expert readers
- **New submissions** are also welcome provided they do fit into the thematic scope

This book is calling for contributions covering amongst others novel methods and concepts on modeling, analysis or design approaches either to explain, predict, and respectively control real nonlinear dynamical systems or related to theoretical electrical engineering. The systems under consideration may be engineering systems, social or economical systems, or even biological systems. Of particular focus will be however be selected systems and/or concepts related to theoretical electrical engineering.

DEALINES / STEPS

Phase 1 - Submission of short CHAPTER Proposals:

Authors are invited to submit a **short proposal** (1000 words maximum) describing the topic and scope of the proposed chapter.

(the keynote speakers just need to confirm their acceptance of writing a chapter for the book)

DEADLINE: **2. October 2011**

Phase 2 – Selection by the editors of proposals:

Notification of authors and invitation to submit full chapters

(the keynote speakers’ chapters proposals are already accepted)

DEADLINE: **10. October 2011**

Phase 3 Full Chapters Submission

Selected Authors (from Phase 2) will be invited to submit a **full chapter proposal** (20 pages maximum).

Authors should all **use the Springer Templates** (word or Latex)

DEADLINE: **15. November 2011**

Phase 4 Review of the submitted Chapters

All submitted chapters will be reviewed and authors will obtain the reviewer’s feedback with a list of recommendations.

DEADLINE: **30. November 2011**

Phase 5 Submission of camera ready versions of the Chapters

The authors should submit final camera ready versions. SPRINGER templates (word or Latex) must be used !

DEADLINE: **15. December 2011**
